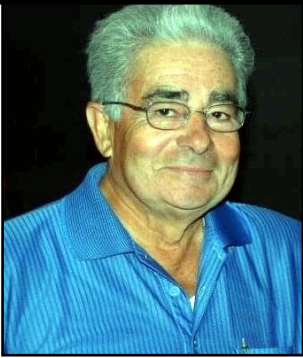

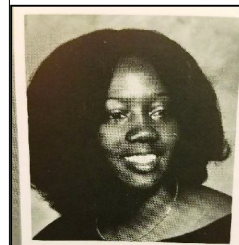

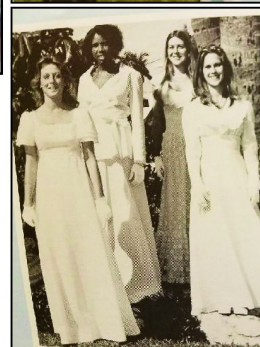
Honoring Dr. Annette Gilbert

DR. ANNETTE GILBERT is a 1975 graduate of Lake Worth Community High School.

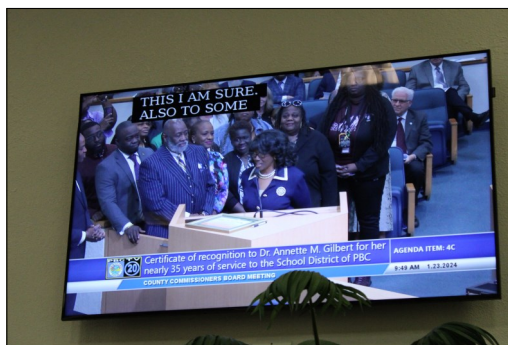
